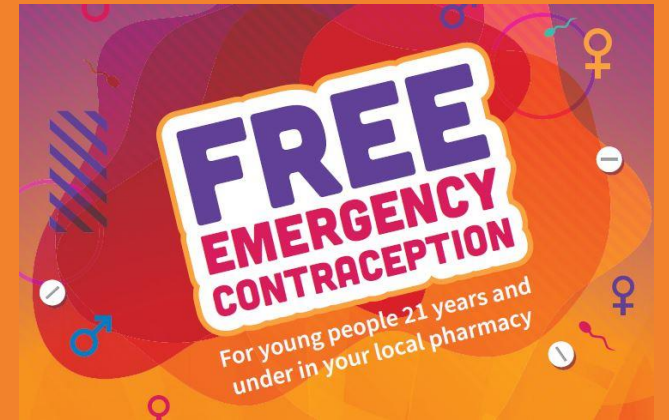

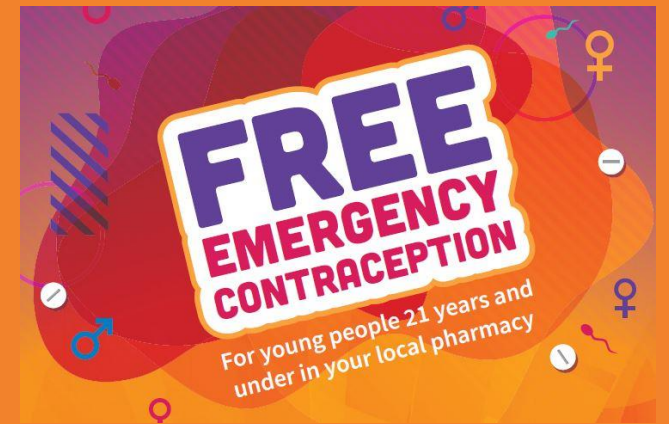

Referrals for vulnerable patients.

1252 issues of EHC, 43 of those between 13 and 15 years

2 referrals to School Health Nurses, none to the sexual health service.

18 of the 43 had a narrative/notes



More on the School Health Nurse offer...

- Follow-up for vulnerable young people, including CSE concerns and onward referral to exploitation services if indicated
- Sign up for C card scheme, on-going supply of condoms
- Face to face appointment to discuss more reliable contraceptive options, including medical and sexual health assessment to determine eligibility and acceptability
- Quick-starting contraception including pill, patch, injection and implant
- Facilitating attendance at mainstream sexual health services/GP for complex contraception or where not available in their school or college (i.e. Implant only available in FE Colleges)
- EHC provision including ellaOne in case of further contraception failure/UPSI
- EHC follow-up pregnancy testing as indicated
- Onward referral to BPAS as required
- STI screening for Chlamydia & Gonorrhoea
- Treatment for Chlamydia as indicated
- On-going work around healthy relationships, safe sex, risk reduction, protective behaviours
